Updated information from the Rectorate on SARS-CoV2

Dear SFU students,

Yesterday the Austrian federal government announced an extension of the measures to contain SARS-CoV2. In relation to this update, the Rectorate of Sigmund Freud PrivatUniversität discussed and decided on the further procedure for the SFU: You, our students, have top priority in all further measures and steps at the SFU. We see it as our duty to focus on your health as intensely as your progress in studies. With this priority setting, the Rectorate has decided on the further course of action and would like to inform you about the following points:

- 1) The “Home Learning” phase at the SFU will continue until Thursday April 30th, 2020.
- 2) All students will be able to complete the summer semester / their degree course according to the curricular course.
- 3) To ensure point 2), all faculties have already prepared online exams as well as online final exams. For specific regulations, please contact your faculty.
- 4) Digital library access is administered via the faculties or branches. These are in close contact with the management of the library in order to design the inventory in the digital area so that relevant literature is accessible to you.

We strive to offer you the best possible support in your respective course of study even under these demanding framework conditions. You can obtain further information from your faculty on an ongoing basis, but also from the Rectorate's mailings.
