§ 1 Objects of the Study Contract

- (1) This Study Contract is intended to determine the rights and obligations of the parties hereto, and to guarantee that, by adhering to these provisions, the Student attains the academic goal and academic title within the projected time frame as foreseen in the curriculum for the International Bachelor Programme in psychology.
- (2) In accordance with the Austrian Private University Act, the University declares that it has been granted accreditation as a private university for psychology and that it is authorized, within the scope of this license, to award academic degrees equal to those awarded by Austrian state universities.
- (3) The notification of accreditation, the relevant curriculum as well as the relevant University Statutes and Regulations accessible to the Student constitute an integrated part of this Study Contract.

§ 2 Obligations of the University

- (1) The University commits itself to implementing the curriculum authorized by the AQ Austria. It expressly reserves the right to amend the curriculum in the event that adjustments to national or EU legislation or changes in academic staff become necessary. Adjustments shall not be detrimental to the achievement of the projected academic goal in any way.
- (2) In the event the University is forced, for whatever reasons, to discontinue the programme of study, it is obligated to support the Student. All examinations taken and skills acquired up to that point will be accredited in accordance with the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS).

§ 3 Obligations of the Student

- (1) The Student shall actively participate in the lectures and seminars designed for the International Bachelor Programme as set forth in the relevant curriculum, and shall abide by the relevant University Statutes and Regulations.
- (2) The University shall have free and unrestricted access and rights of use over any work performed and research outcome obtained by the Student as well as to any research results gained by the Student as part of a research project and within the scope of the Student's studies.



§ 4 Place of Performance

The place of performance for all claims arising out of this Study Contract shall be the University's premises.

§ 5 Duration of Study Contract and Provisions for Premature Termination

- (1) This Study Contract shall be in force for the duration required until reaching the academic goal, that means 6 semesters at least.
- (2) The parties to this Study Contract shall be entitled to terminate this Study Contract prematurely at the end of every semester (January 31st and August 31st) by giving a two months' notice.
- (3) The Student shall have the right to terminate this Study Contract without reason.
- (4) The University may terminate this Study Contract prematurely upon the decision of the Rectorate. This Study Contract may be terminated by the University especially in the event of:
- a. grave or repeated breaches of any provisions as laid down in the University Statutes and Regulations by the Student
- b. a Student's non-achievement of the academic goal as set forth in the curriculum
- c. incomplete payment of University tuition fees, in which case the University shall have the right to claim payment of any outstanding tuition fees until valid termination of this Study Contract.

§ 6 Applicable Law and Jurisdiction

This Study Contract and any disputes which may arise in connection with it shall be governed by Austrian law. The parties hereto submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent court in Vienna.

§ 7 Severability Clause

In the event that any or more provisions contained herein shall be held to be invalid, this shall not affect any other provisions of this Study Contract. The parties hereto shall at once replace any such invalid condition with a valid provision that most closely matches the original aim of this Study Contract. The same procedure shall apply for any or more loopholes contained in this Study Contract.



§ 8 Amendments to the Study Contract

Any amendments to this Study Contract as well as termination of it shall be made in writing. Likewise, any request for modification of the written form shall be given in writing.

§ 9 Tuition Fees and Payment

The tuition fees

for the Bachelor Programme amount to

EUR 7,215 per semester.

The total amount payable by the Student is six times the amount of the fees payable for one semester. In addition, a one-time enrolment fee of EUR 480 is due before the start of the semester.

Exceeding the minimum duration of study by a total of one year per degree program does not change the total fees.

In case of exceeding the minimum duration of studies by more than one year per degree program, the university reserves the right to charge further tuition fees (except in justified cases such as pregnancy, illness).

Falling below the personal study duration while maintaining the same ECTS performance does not change the tuition fees.

Tuition fees shall become due at the commencement of each semester and may also be paid in instalments.

The University shall be entitled to increase tuition fees in the event that the Austrian Consumer Price Index (VPI) rate 12/2019 should rise by more than five percent. The adjusted amount payable shall be rounded up to the nearest EUR 10. Such an adjustment of fees shall become effective at the commencement of the subsequent semester.
