Nicole Heussen is a biostatistician. After studying statistics in Dortmund, she obtained her doctorate in theoretical medicine in 2004 and habilitated in medical biometry and clinical epidemiology at the Medical Faculty of RWTH Aachen University in 2012. There she teaches and conducts research at the Institute for Medical Statistics.
